**1. Fight the Good Fight**

It was addressed to you by name, then continued with these words: Thus saith the LORD: "Read 2 Tim 4, for I have something for you there." Which verse or verses in this chapter do you think He most likely would be referring to?*

Q.5 *If you were asked to write a discussion question to help your Bible study group apply something in this chapter to their lives, how would you word the question?*
