1. According to Ephesians 4:17-19, how do the mind, heart, and conscience influence the actions of non believers? How are Christians to deal with these realities? How does putting on the “New Self” lead to inner change?
2. Ponder this. Can the heart be changed without a resulting change of conduct?
3. According to Paul, what specific behaviours distinguish the Christian lifestyle from the pagans? (4:25- 5:4)
4. Of the different pictures of what it means to live as a Christian, (putting off, putting on, imitating God, and being light instead of darkness, which means the most to you? Why?
5. Focussing on the attitude of forgiveness in this final question, respond to this quote from Corrie ten Boom :

“Forgiveness is an act of the will, and the will can function regardless of the temperature of the heart.”



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
